In order to proceed with the injury investigation of the sunset review concerning the antidumping duty order on carbon steel plate from Brazil, China, India, Indonesia, Korea and Ukraine, the International Trade Commission (ITC) will conduct a hearing to provide an opportunity for face-to-face communication between representatives of domestic producers, foreign producers and exporters, importers, and other interested parties.
