- 5.Volume exported to third countries, with FOB prices
- 6.Home market shipments
- 7.Data projected concerning the above items from the second to the fourth quarter of 2007.


Furthermore, please provide us with some brief introductory materials and annual reports of your company in English, which include information concerning company structure, anufacturing process, and product types.

In order to make final injury determination within 40 days, which is specified in our regulation, please return the required data and materials to us no later than June. 20, 2007, by fax, airmail, or e-mail. Although failing to submit the required data on time in the final injury investigation phase shall not be prejudicial to the definitive injury determination, your cooperation would be advantageous to your company and is therefore strongly encouraged.
